Who is eligible to receive a kit containing NARCAN® Nasal Spray?

As of November 10, 2017, the Régie de l'assurance maladie du Québec (the Régie) will reimburse the cost of NARCAN[®] Nasal Spray* and the supplies necessary to administer them to all persons age 14 or over who request them from a pharmacist.¹

Eligible persons must:

- Be age 14 or over
- Reside in Québec and be duly registered with the Régie
- Present their valid health insurance card, claim slip (carnet de réclamation) or proof of temporary eligibility

In the absence of the above documents:

You can still provide kits containing NARCAN® Nasal Spray under certain circumstances:

- Persons whose condition requires urgent care
- · Minors age 14 years or over
- Homeless persons
- Citizens of another Canadian province or territory, foreign nationals and tourists who present their ID (such as a passport)

* Eligible recipients have the choice between obtaining NARCAN® Nasal Spray or injectable naloxone from their pharmacist.

Verify identity

- New intervention or exception code MK* for a particular situation must be transmitted in the interactive communication system in pharmacy (CIP)
 - MK: to generate a temporary NAM as part of a free program

Billing instructions⁶

Billing of services

To obtain reimbursement from the Régie, the following information is necessary:

- One payment request per service
 - e.g., billing for the dispensing of a new script and billing for the training and education about naloxone should be submitted as separate payment requests
- Program code:
 - · 8K: Medication and supplies billed on behalf of the opioid user
 - $^\circ$ 8L: Medication and supplies invoiced on behalf of the person who can intervene with a person using opioids

- · Although no prescription is required, the following is mandatory:
 - Prescription number
 - Nature and expression of the prescription (new written (N) or verbal (V) prescription)
 - Number of renewals must equal 0 (any prescription renewal will be refused)
 - Processing time must be different than 0



Billing instructions⁶

Billing of services (continued)

The maximum allowable quantities per service for naloxone or its supplies may be exceeded, but the new intervention or exception code MS must be entered on the request for payment.

MS: to allow the maximum quantity to be exceeded per service

The service code and billing code for the drug or supplies must be entered on each payment request, depending on the service provided.
